You might have students that are eligible for additional educational resources and services from the Migrant Education Program.

Who is eligible?

Students that have moved into your district in the last three years that have moved with an agricultural farmworker or have moved for the purpose to work in agriculture themselves.

How can you help?

Why should you provide a referral?

The Migrant Education Program is part of Title I (Title I Part C). It was designed to help students who have gaps in their education through supplemental educational programs. These are programs like tutoring, summer school, in-home instruction, parental involvement programs, and much more. Funding is available to assist students, but it is necessary to find eligible children first and then help them overcome their educational gaps. Referrals from school districts are critical.
